Since last meeting, all board members and officers have been working hard to finish their specific tasks discussed and assigned. SICET president, Tina Wu called for a meeting to discuss progress in each area and to plan what to do next.

1. Report on the AECT/SICET 2011 Convention (Christie Liu/Chih-Hsiung Liu)

- 1) Attended bi-weekly AECT planning committee meetings between December 2010 and March 2011;
- 2) Participated in the training of using AllAcademics, the AECT online conference planning/management system;
- 3) Calls for proposals sent to SICETLIST in both English and Chinese between January and March;
- 4) Call for Reviewers and Proposal Review sent to the SICET members;
- 5) Fourteen members volunteered to be proposal reviewers and the review was successfully completed on March 22;
- 6) Conference Proposals A total of 19 proposals submitted to the 2011 AECT/SICET convention, as concurrent, reflection, panel and roundtable sessions and all accepted;

7) Finalize the status report of these proposals and contact the authors about necessary updates on session types.

2. Report on the Summer Fellowship Program (Dongyuan Chen);

- 1) Contacted universities in China for hosting our 2011 Summer Fellowship since 2010 AECT conference:
- Three hosting institutes chosen: Foreign Languages Department of Luoyang University of Science and Engineering, Educational Bureau of Luoning County, and Foreign Languages College of Hangzhou University of Electronic Science and Technology;
- 3) A call for proposal was sent out early in January 2011 and friendly reminders were sent before the deadline;
- 4) 15 proposals were received from nine SICET members and six proposals were accepted based on the interests of the hosting institutes;
- 5) Six acceptance letters and three rejection letters were sent out in late February. Only four out of the six accepted proposals were confirmed.

3. Report on paper-based journal (Harrison Yang);

- 1) In the middle of October 2011, both online and print versions of the third issue of JETDE were published;
- 2) Copies of the print version JETDE were delivered at AECE/SICET 2011 Convention (by Dr. Shuyan Wang, Managing Editor) and mailed to authors (by Harrison);
- 3) Copies of the print version JETDE were shared at the Joint Conference of International Educational Technology Research and Deans/Chairs' Forum, Beijing, China, October 16-17, 2010 (by Dr. Hongbo Song, Associate Editor and Harrison);
- 4) The "call for papers" for the fourth issue of JETED will be announced on April 5, 2011.

4. Membership recruitment and management (Chih-Hsiung Tu)

- 1) A total of 84 members with 4 new members since the Anaheim conference;
- 2) Will contact the authors whose proposal accepted by SICET and encourage them to join AECT through SICET with the special membership rate;
- 3) Will encourage the presenters to become AECT members through SICET via "Join AECT/SICET Membership Program" at Jacksonville conference;

5. Financial Report (Hong Zhan)

- 1) From October 1, 2010 to March 30, 2011, SICET received \$260 membership fee from which \$73 was transferred to ACET;
- 2) The total expenses during this period is \$408.08, which were used for 2010 SICET annual conference expenses and SICET bank account service fee;
- 3) The current balance is \$3835.25, which is \$148.08 less than the balance report in September 2010;

4) Recruiting more new members is a way to continue the healthy financial situation for SICET.

6. Report from regional directors (Hongbo Song, Geping Liu, Simon So, and Hsiujen Cheng)

Hongbo Song:

- 1) 100 copies of 2010 issue of JETDE were given to Harrison Yang during the conference held in Tsinghua University October 2010;
- 2) Sent 25 copies of 2010 issue of JETDE to Harrison Yang in Beijing October 2010;
- 3) Will bring 50 copies of 2010 issue of JETDE to Hangzhou May 2011.

Geping Liu:

- 1) Introduced SICET in the annual conference of Chongqing Association for Educational Technology in Higher Education in December 2010.
- 2) Plan to introduce SICET in some conferences and meetings in 2011.
- 3) Plan to contact with some academic associations for cooperating with SICET.

Simon So:

- 1) Received 6 hardcopies of JETDE (Vol. 3. No.1). Copies are available online as well as in Hong Kong Institute of Education;
- 2) Attended and presented a keynote speech in SICET 2010 Convention.
- 3) Participated and reported in the association meeting 2010.

Hsiujen Cheng:

- 1) The brochures and website of SIECT have been distributed and introduced to graduate students in Department of Teaching Chinese as a Second Language at Chung Yuan University in the beginning of 2010;
- 2) Students were interested in SIECT and those potential members are encouraged to join in;
- 3) More members are expected to be recruited this year;
- 4) Our brochures are planning to be included in the package of conferences which will be held in May of 2010.

7. Communications among SICET members: newsletter, brochure, and minutes (Guoqiang Cui)

- 1) Minutes drafted for last online board meeting around October 2010 and kept documents of our activities;
- 2) Called for news from our SICET members and created our SICET newsletter fall 2010;
- 3) Will call for news for the next newsletter;

8. SICET Web site update and maintenance (Youmei Liu)

1) Launched new SICET site;

2) Updating the site contacts, some content and mailing list;

9. SICET Facebook (Yi Yang)

- 1) Created a Facebook page for SICET and will create a self-defined username soon;
- 2) Transfer information from SICET website to SICET Facebook page;
- 3) SIECT Facebook page is open to the public, and everyone can post comments.

10. Online Journal IJTTL (Leping Liu)

- 1) IJTTL now is in its seventh year of publication with two issues per year: one in June, and the other by the end of the year;
- 2) The first issue of 2011 is at the review-stage, and still accepting new submissions until the end of June;
- 3) The acceptance rate of IJTTL is between 28% and 35% (by issue);
- 4) IJTTL has been recognized in the field with a very sounding reputation;
- 5) Advocated IJTTL at editorial session at SITE;
- 6) Sent out the call for papers at the SITE conference, and discussed with future potential authors.

11. Plan for the future: Form the Board Members Election committee and Mentor program

11.1 Form the Board Members Election committee

- 1) Since several of our board members will finish their term serving in the SICET board at the annual convention 2011, SICET president Dr. Tina Wu suggested that Dr. Chih-Hsiung Tu and Dr. Shuyan Wang be in charge of the election process during August and September, 2011;
- 2) Dr. Chih-Hsiung Tu will take the lead and Dr. Shuyan Wang will assist;
- 3) Call for nomination will be sent out in August, 2011.

11.2 Mentor program:

- 1) Dr. Chih-Hsiung Tu proposed a mentoring program for SICE graduate students and perhaps junior faculties;
- 2) Proposed ideas about the program:
 - Solicit mentors and mentees;
 - Pair mentor and mentees;
 - Mentor and mentee could carry conversations;
 - Setup a time for them to meet face-to-face at AECT annual conference and to share how their mentoring experiences;
 - Mentor and mentees can work collaboratively on some project, topics, presentations etc.
- 3) The motion was not passed yet.

The online board meeting was adjourned on April 2, 2011.
