Looking back, SICET had another productive year: our online journal, *IJTTL*, published its first issue of this year as scheduled in June 2010; the second issue of *JETDE* was published on Oct. 15, 2009; the fifth



SICET Annual Convention was held in Louisville, Kentucky, USA on Oct. 27-31, 2009; and the seventh Summer Fellowship Program were successfully hosted by Guangxi Institute of Education (Naning, Guangxi) and Linyi Normal University (Linyi, Shangdong) during May 2010.

During the fifth Annual Convention, the keynote speaker, Dr. Hongbo Song, shared various multimedia products they created for language teaching and learning in Yantai University. Two invited speakers, Dr. Pinde Chen and Dr. Jinrong Li, introduced the educational technology programs at their universities. These presentations gave audience a complete picture of the technology integration in China. SICET hosted 14 concurrent presentations and 7 round-table presentations as well as one distance presentation. These presentations discussed different aspects of technology integrations in educational settings. Among them, Dr. Chun-Min Wang was awarded the best presentation and Mr. Guoqiang Cui was awarded the best student presentation. Both awardees were selected according to the evaluations submitted by the audience. All current SICET student members who presented as the key presenter received one year free membership.

As for the Summer Fellowship program this year, 11 SICET members submitted 12 proposals. Among them, five members' proposals were selected to present at Guangxi Institute of Education, and nine members' proposals were selected to present at Linyi Normal University. This activity provided our members and the host university a great opportunity to share their teaching experiences, research ideas and fundings with teachers and students from different universities in China and the USA.

2010 SICET Annual Convention



The Society of International Chinese in Educational Technology (SICET) will host its sixth annual conference as part of the 2010 Association for Educational Communications and Technology (AECT) international convention, "Cyber Change: Learning in

Our Connected World', on October 26-30, 2010. At its annual convention, SICET sponsors two keynote presentations, 2 general sessions, and 14 concurrent presentations. All these SICET sessions will be hosted in North Tower - 2nd Floor, Salon VI, in Hyatt Regency Orange County, Anaheim, California.

The two keynote speakers are Dr Simon So, a faculty member in Information Technology at the Hong Kong Institute of Education, and Dr. Geping Liu, Professor and Associate Dean from Southwest University, China. Dr. So will discuss "Pedagogical & Technological Considerations of Mobile Learning" and Dr. Liu will talk about "E-Learning in Higher Education in China: Current Practice & Future Trends" at 1:00pm and 1:30pm, on Wednesday, October 27.

The concurrent presentations include various topics related to technology integration, online learning, media-based and mobile learning, Web 2.0 and Second Life. The international

touch of SICET is reflected in presentations that explore and research on the use of emerging technologies such as cross-cultural online learning and Second Life in learning English as a Second Language.

The general sessions will report the progress achieved last year, present the "Best Presentation Award" & "Key Student Presenter Award". We will also discuss the activities planned for next year, and share information on how to get involved in international exchange. Programs such as summer fellowship trips to the universities in China will be discussed in details at the two general sessions.

Keynote Speakers Introduction



Dr Simon So (BSc, PGDE, MEd, PhD) is the Regional Director of Hong Kong, SICET. He is currently a faculty member in Information Technology at the Hong Kong Institute of Education, Department of Mathematics and Information Technology. He is a registered professional engineer in Australia and a registered teacher in Hong Kong. Dr. So has many years of working experience. He has held various technical and managerial positions in IT industry in the past. His academic experience spans many universities; the University of Alberta, the University of Hong Kong, the Hong Kong Polytechnic University, the University of Melbourne, Karratha College (for Edith Cowan University) and Victoria University. He has published research articles widely and his publications include books' chapters and articles in journals, professional series and international conferences. His services to the international research community include serving as Program Committee Member, Organizing Member, Technical Expert and Regional Director of major international conferences and professional organizations in Australia, Europe, Asia and US. He served as External Examiner for a number of doctorial and master research dissertations and Reviewer of many journal articles and conference papers internationally. Dr. So also serves as the subject member and provides consultation works for government bodies in education. He

is a member of the Curriculum Development Council Committee on Technology Education in Hong Kong and is the setter of public examination papers for Hong Kong Examination and Assessment Authority in many years. His research interests include Mobile Learning, Game-based Learning, Educational Use of Multimedia and Internet Technologies, Multimedia Information Retrieval and Web Standards.

In this keynote speech, Dr. Simon So will present on the pedagogical and technological considerations of mobile learning. Teaching and learning activities can embrace mobile technologies as pedagogical tools for effective learning. He will draw on examples from the literature to highlight the pedagogical and technological aspects of mobile learning. His ongoing research

Dr. Geping Liu got his bachelor degree at Southwest China Normal University in 1989, master degree at Beijing Normal University in 1996, and doctor degree at Southwest China Normal University in 2005. He did research as a visiting scholar at

University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign from 2007 to 2008. He has worked at the Online Education College of Southwest University (SWU) as a vice dean for ten years. Now, Dr. Liu is the director of Information Technology Center of SWU.

Dr. Liu's research focuses on distance education, especially online learning system. Currently, He is interested in Web 2.0 and e-Learning 2.0, Virtual World in Education, Intelligent Tutoring System etc.

Recently, Dr. Liu published some articles in e-Learning 2.0 areas, such as "Primary Discussions of e-Learning 2.0", "Web 2.0-Based Learning and e-Learning 2.0" and "Study of SecondLife Based Online Situated Learning".

Dr. Liu's presentation will introduce the E-learning in higher education in China. Online distance education in higher education in China began in 1999. By now, there are more than 4 million students learning in online education system. Dr. Liu will discuss the current policy and the future trend of online learning in higher education. He will also present a case study on online education in Southwest University (SWU).
