General Information

The 7th Annual Summer Fellowship Program plans to hold two events in 2010 at <u>Guangxi Institute of Education (广西教育学院)</u>, <u>Nanning</u>, <u>Guangxi</u>, (May 19-21, 2010) and at <u>Linyi Normal University</u> (临沂师范学院) at <u>Linyi</u>, <u>Shandong</u>, P. R. China (May 26 – 30, 2010) (Dates are tentative).

The theme for these two Events is "**Educational Technology for Learning and Instructions**." Under this theme, following topic areas are suggested for presentation proposals.

Suggested Topic Areas for the Events:

- 1. Development Trends and Issues of Educational Technology in EFL Instructions;
- Trends and issues of educational technology programs in American universities (major US universities, university program course structures, research focus, and prominent professors and their contributions to the field, and etc.);
- 3. Educational technology in professional development and teacher education/training;
- 4. Collaboration, learning community, social learning, social networking, communities of practices, and peer interaction;
- New technologies and new pedagogical possibilities (esp. mobile learning, game-based learning & creative learning with technology, virtual technology, human performance technology, and etc.);

- 6. Issues and trends in distance education;
- 7. Research on technology application/integration in science, math., physics, chemistry, and language education and other education fields;
- 8. Design and development of learning environments (esp. technologyenriched/online/virtual learning environments, learning and instruction courseware/platform, and etc.).

How to Apply

Submit your presentation proposals as an attachment to "<u>xwang10@gsu.edu</u>" with the email subject "Guangxi," "Linyi" or "Guangxi & Linyi" if you submit your presentations to both events. You are strongly recommended to submit multiple presentations for both Events and single presentation proposal can be submitted to both Events. Please also include a copy of your updated resume with your submission. Each proposal should be saved as an individual WORD file that includes the following:

- 1. A presentation title
- 2. An abstract of 100 ~150 words with three key words/phrases
- 3. A body of proposal between 600 to 1000 words.

SICET will form a committee to work with Guangxi Institute of Education and Linyi Normal University to review the proposals using following criteria:

- 1. Relevance to the Event theme (1-10 points)
- 2. Content quality (1-20 Points)
 - a. Proposal organization (1-10 points)
 - b. Proposal clarity (1-10 points)

Travel and Accommodation

The Event participants are responsible for their own travel arrangements and travel related expenses (both international and domestic). The host institutions will provide the participants with accommodations (lodge and food), and local transportation (Nanning, Guangxi and Linyi, Shandong) only.
