#### **SICET 10th Anniversary: A Personal Reflection**



In March 2003, at Albuquerque, NM, a group of Chinese scholars majoring in Educational/Instructional Technology met at SITE (Society for Information Technology and Teacher Education) 13<sup>th</sup> Annual International Conference. That was a time when many Chinese professors and students who were working in instructional technology field at different universities in the United States gathered together to present their research findings. They felt a need to form an association to gather all the Chinese scholars in North America together so that they could have their own voice in the IT field. I still remember the time when Dr. Ouyang

stopped me at the elevator and discussed this idea with me. When we both agreed with each other, he encouraged me to talk to other Chinese scholars. He said there were also other Chinese professors trying to reach as many Chinese scholars as possible. As a knot of the whole net, I spread the words out as well. Later in that day, all Chinese scholars who were interested met in front of the gate and discussed more about this proposal. Board members and officers were elected at that time. Dr. Steve Yuen was elected as the president and Dr. Ouyang as the Vice President. Other officers included Fengqi Lai, Guoli Liang, and Lih-Ching Wang, The picture was taken at that time to document that important moment. We joked that this picture would have historical meaning, indicating the first milestone of SICET.

Under the leadership of various board members and officers, SICET established its name, bylaw, the official Web site, newsletters, brochures, refereed academic journals, Summer fellowship events, and international conferences. Some important events include:

- Summer 2004, the first SICET Summer Fellowship was launched. As of today, we successfully held 10 Summer Fellowship trips and conducted 22 academic events at 20 different universities, which provided a platform for the scholars in US and China to exchange their research results, share their teaching experiences, and establish possible collaborations in the area of educational technology.
- In 2004, SICET assigned Dr. Geping Liu and Jihua Song as regional directors in Mainland and Dr. Simon So in Hong Kong.
- 3. In 2005, SICET became one of the affiliates of AECT (Association for Educational Communications and Technology) and jointly hosted SICET's first annual convention with AECT in Orlando, FL. The 8<sup>th</sup> SICET/ACET annual convention will be held in Anaheim, CA, on Oct. 27-31, 2013.
- 4. In 2005, the first SICET official refereed journal (semi-annual, online), *The International Journal of Technology in Teaching and Learning (IJTTL)*, was launched by Dr. Leping Liu. This is the ninth year of IJTTL, and it now has an established reputation in the field.
- 5. In 2007, Dr. Hongbo Song was named the Regional Director in North China and Dr. Hsiu-Jen Cheng the Regional Director in Taiwan. Dr. Geping Liu and Dr. Simon So continued serving as the Regional Directors in South China and Hong Kong.
- 6. In 2008, the second SICET official refereed journal, *The Journal of Educational Technology Development and Exchange (JETDE)*, was launched by Dr. Harrison Hao Yang. JETDE was published both online and in print annually during the first four years (2008-2011) and two issues in 2012. Now JETDE publishes four issues every year.


- 7. In August 2012, SICET organized the first international conference, Educational Innovation through Technology (EITT), which was hosted by Tsinghua University. EITT 2012 was a great success with over 240 participants from seven different countries and regions. Among them, 61 presented their research results in four concurrent presentation rooms. In addition, 18 top experts gave keynote or plenary speeches. Proceedings of EITT 2012 collected 92 papers which were chosen from 130 submissions through a standard peer-reviewed process. The Second annual conference will be held in Williamsburg, VA on November 4-6, 2013.
- 8. During EITT 2012, the Asian-Pacific Chapter of SICET was established. Currently, SICET has over 30 affiliate universities and about 400 members all over the world. Dr. Jiangang Cheng was elected as the president of Asian-Pacific.

As a SICET member (2003-present), board member (2005-2010, 2011-2015), and officer (Director of Technology 2005-2006, Vice President 2006-2007, President 2007-2010, President Advisor 2010-2011, Vice president 2011-2013), I have witnessed the growth of SICET in the past ten years. The development of SICET was founded on the hard work and continuous contributions from past and current board members, officers, and members. I really appreciate the guidance and support from Drs. Harrison Yang, Steve Yuan, and Youmei Liu during my presidency terms. I want to express my gratitude to my team members from my different terms including Drs. Harrison Yang, Hong Zhan, Xiaoxue Wang, Youmei Liu, Yuxin Ma, Leping Liu, Tina Wu, Juhong Liu, Yuliang Liu, Jeson Lei, Dongyuan Cheng, Hong Wang, Hui-Long Hung, Guoqiang Cui, Chih-Tsiung Tu, Xibin Han, and Yi Yang. I also want to extend my appreciation to our regional Directors Drs. Simon So in Hong Kong, Hongbo Song and Geping Liu in Mainland, and Hsiu-Jen Cheng in Taiwan as well as Drs. Jiangang Cheng, Nian-Hsing Chen, and Xibin Han for their time and efforts in establishing SICET Asian-Pacific Chapter and hosting EITT 2012 and EITT 2013.

It was the understanding, support, and involvement of each SICET member, board members, and officer that allowed SICET to grow and achieve what we have today. I remember that Dr. Youmei Liu provided tremendous help for Website redesign and kept maintaining the SICET domain for years; Dr. Hong Zhan spent large amount

of time to consult bank account and tax exempt possibilities; Dr. Hongbo Song supported JETDE in its hardest time; Dr. Pearl Chen, Dr. Taralynn Hartsell, Dr. David Stone, Dr. Jennifer Styron, Dr. Guoqiang Cui, and many others who provided help whenever needed, no matter how busy they were. I will never forget the long chats over the phone with Harrison during late evenings or weekends about the issues and concerns of SICET. Like Geping said, "SICET is like a family". We understand, care, and support each other.

Although I devoted most of my time to SICET in the past ten year, it was a rewarding experience because I gained a lot of friendship and established connections with the scholars in Mainland, Taiwan, Hong Kong, and other regions. I also received more opportunities to collaborate with other IT experts in teaching and research. Looking back, I feel very grateful because I always had very supportive teams working with me. I would like to take this opportunity to express my appreciation to SICET members and board members for your understanding, support, and involvement in the past ten years. Because of your efforts and contributions, SICET has achieved tremendous progresses and successes.







#### Xiaojun Chen




