The Society of International Chinese in Educational Technology (SICET) will host its seventh annual conference as part of the 2011 Association for Educational Communications and Technology (AECT) international convention, “**Celebrate 3.0: Design Learn Community**”, on November 8-12, 2011. At its annual convention, SICET sponsors two keynote presentations, 2 general sessions, 6 concurrent presentations, and 6 roundtable presentations.
